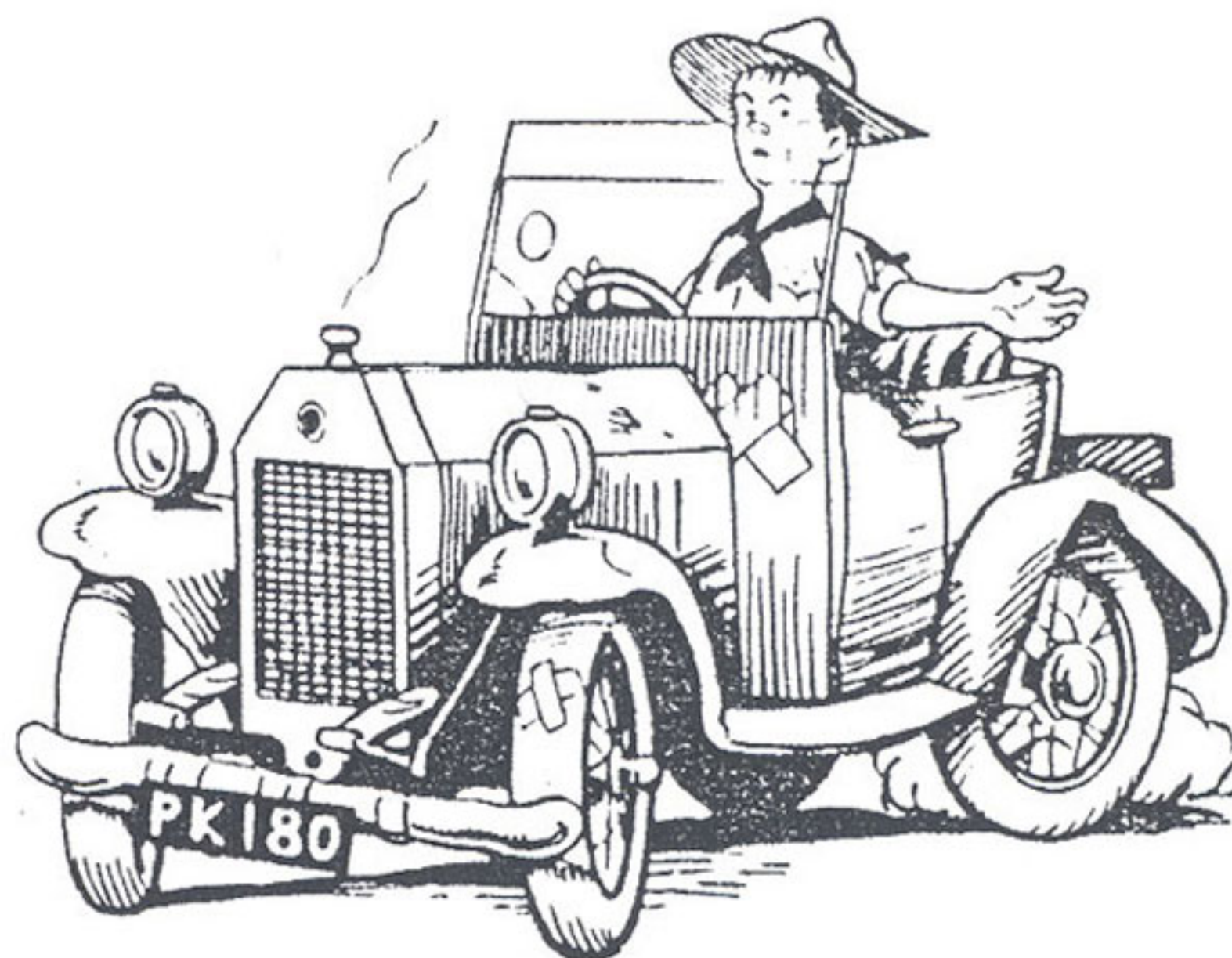

# 1907-1957

**W**ELCOME to our eighth "Gang Show," which is the first local occasion on which Harpenden Boy Scouts can join with others all over the world in celebrating two great anniversaries. 1957 is the Golden Jubilee year of the beginning of the Scout Movement and it is also the Centenary of the birth of the Founder.

In many ways Scouting was not founded at all, but "grew up" spontaneously and almost overnight. Although local records are not in existence, Harpenden must have seen Boy Scouts in the very earliest days, for at least one group can claim a start in about 1909 or 1910. Today there is a local membership of over 300 Wolf Cubs, Scouts and Senior Scouts, Rovers and Scouters, and there is a continuous stream of boys who want to be Scouts. The main restriction on expansion is the lack of leaders and any man or woman who feels able to do one of the very many jobs in Scouting will always be welcome.

Jointly with the Girl Guides, Harpenden Boy Scouts hope to make 1957 a memorial year for Harpenden and several events are already planned. We hope the Public will be pleased with what they see of us and our activities and will give encouragement to Scouting to look forward to another fifty years.
