

Which is the first local occasion on which Harpenden Boy Scouts can join with others all over the world in celebrating two great anniversaries. 1957 is the Golden Jubilee year of the beginning of the Scout Movement and it is also the Centenary of the birth of the Founder.

In many ways Sconting was not founded at all, but "grew up" spontaneously and almost overnight. Although local records are not in existence, Harpenden must have seen Boy Scouts in the very earliest days, for at least one group can claim a start in about 1909 or 1910. Today there is a local membership of over 300 Wolf Cubs, Scouts and Senior Scouts, Rovers and Scouters, and there is a continuous stream of boys who want to be Scouts. The main restriction on expansion is the lack of




