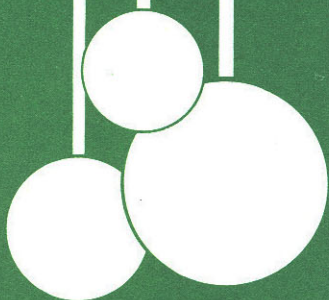

**ROLAND SWALLOW**

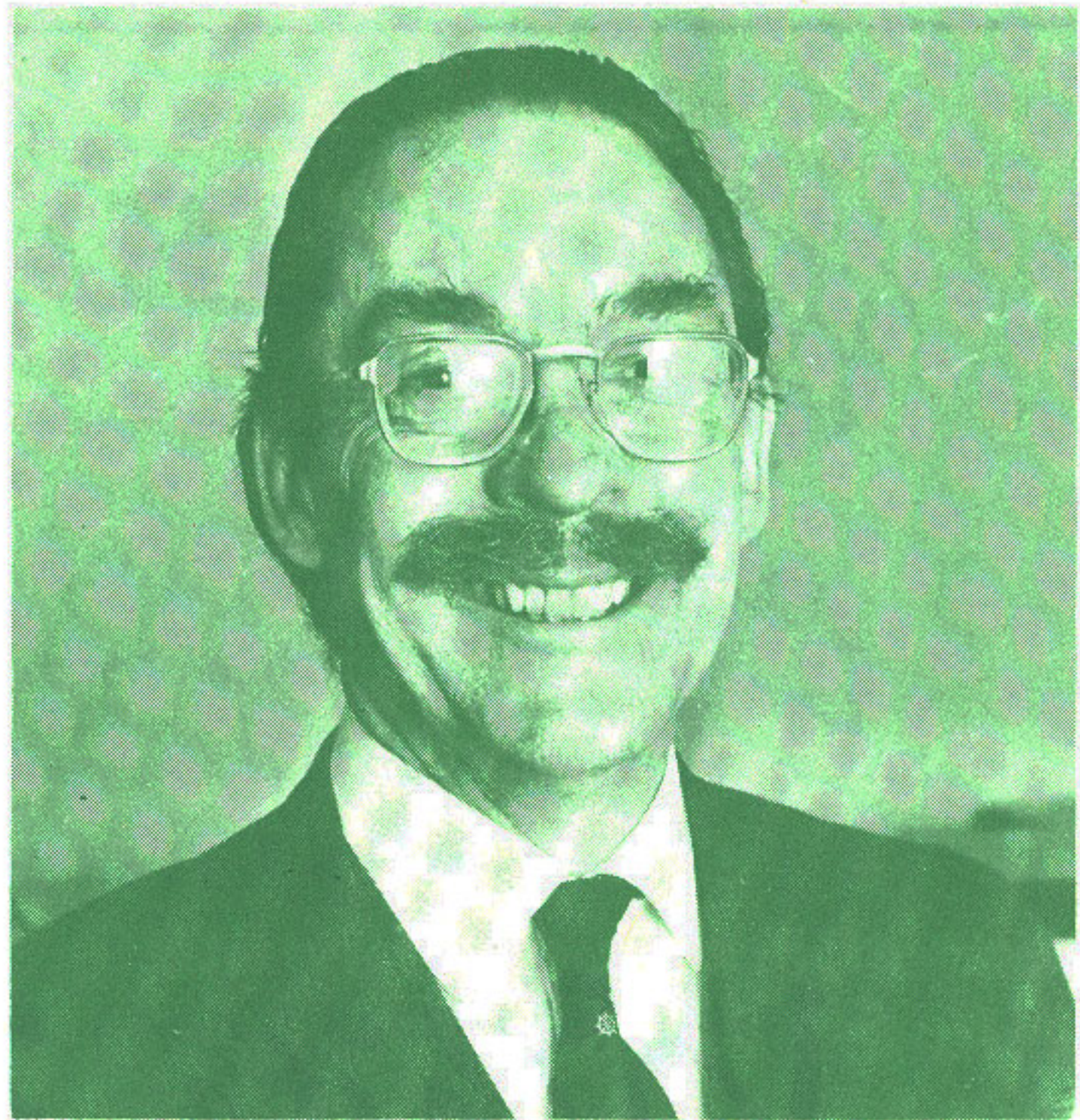
