An appreciation

Whether Eric Thair persuaded the District Committee to put on a Gang Show or whether they asked him is no longer remembered, but he took a completely raw bunch of Scouts and Cubs and brought them through a disastrous dress rehearsal to resounding success in the very first Harpenden and Wheathampstead District Gang Show in October 1949. He did it over and over again for the first 19 shows.

On stage, Eric was erratic but would ad-lib his way out of trouble and was beloved by audience and cast alike. He brought the same fresh, often chaotic enthusiasm to the Gang Show, never refusing any boy a place and reputedly telling a lad who had never been to a rehearsal to 'Get on there boy and do what the others are doing!'.

No 'boy' who was in his shows will ever forget Eric.

I was asked to help Eric Thair with the 1968 Harpenden Gang Show and found myself in the 'hot seat' on the last night when he announced his retirement. As a new boy I approached the 1969 show with some trepidation, but I needn't have worried. The marvellous support team already in place rallied round and made the whole thing so easy and enjoyable. We took the plunge and invited girls in for the first time and I think their song and dance routine was much enjoyed (I enjoyed it anyway!).

I have never forgotten the kind reception given to my first attempt in Harpenden and was looking forward to the following year when fate intervened and my job moved me to Birmingham and I had to pull out. I still have happy memories of the whole thing and the many friends I made.

Here's to the next 60 years!

One of the greatest features of Harpenden Gang Show has always been its continuity. Once rehearsals moved to the Public Hall in show week I would push open the doors and there they all were – parents and friends busy making costumes, turning up hems and letting out gussets whilst persuading many a teenage girl that their costumes were infinitely flattering. I sometimes suspected that they had been there all the time, sewing machines at the ready, during the intervening 51 weeks! Backstage were more parents, Scouters and ex-Scouts busy with scenery, lighting, sound and props, whilst elsewhere were the legions of men and women who combed, cleaned, ironed, fed and 'shushed' their charges every night during the first week in January. On the night there would be the same faces in the same seats – a permanent feature in spite of power cuts, snow storms and 'flu epidemics.

It is many years since I spent a great deal of time convincing District Scouters that the Gang Show was as essential a part of Scouting as Peak Assault and tying knots. Regularly there have been members tap-dancing on the front row one week having performed creditably in Peak Assault just three months earlier. I am sure that B-P's vision of Scouting is manifest in Harpenden and Wheathampstead's all-rounders.

And now on stage we have children and grandchildren of former cast members, and the Show continues to have the support and approval of the local community.

I remember too, also many years ago, the small cub who incurred the wrath of our stand-in accompanist by telling him that "Mr Swallow doesn't play those notes like that" and then demonstrating how it should be done. Years later that cub is still around; inspiring the tone-deaf; bringing out the hidden talents of so many young people; constantly ensuring that the enjoyment of the cast is contagious. He also writes the Show, plays most of the instruments and would be up on stage too if he didn't believe so fervently that the Gang Show stage is for young people, not for adults. He was the bane of my life, a constant challenge during my production years ... and is called Ewan.

He is the greatest producer of the best family show there is – run by families for families. Harpenden and Wheathampstead Gang Show.

I will be thinking of you all and urging you to smile on what I am sure will be the greatest of all 60 Shows. And as for the next 60 years – look out! The next Producer may be on stage tonight!
