Sometimes we're flailing,


Though all you see seems like plain sailing

Sally Clark (Gang Show Committee Chair)

Sally has been involved with the show in various forms on and off for over 20 years. She has only once appeared on the stage - dressed in a leotard, face painted blue and holding an umbrella across her body! As a Venture Scout she was Prop master, making props and delivering them on stage at the appropriate moment. As Venture Scout Leader in the 80's and 90's, she was involved organising Stewards and Front of House. She is currently the Chair of the Gang Show Committee.

She feels that she got so much out of being involved with the show that she is now giving back so as to enable others to also enjoy being part of the Gang Show.

When watching the show she always gets a tingle down the back of her spine as the performers sing and dance their numbers, knowing they have learnt it all since September. "This makes all the committee meetings worth their while!"

Beryl Jeffs (Wardrobe)

Beryl loves the Gang Show and has many memories spanning the 25 years she has been involved, since her daughter Clare first braved the stage back in 1986. Beryl was recruited by Joan Hall & Hazel Ogglesby to sew costumes. One year she made 48 skirts in black, grey, white or navy

and they are still in use now. She drafted in the help of her mother and mother-in-law for sewing buttons on orange dungarees, threading elastic into skirts and generally helping out. There was a year when, after the first night, the production team decided they did not like the scout costumes and the costume ladies all set to work cutting out and making new scout 'dancing girl' dresses ready for that evening's show!

The Jeffs family have all been incorporated into the Gang Show. One year Beryl was sewing before the show and also ironing under the stage during show week; Clare was in the show; son Adrian was a Scout helping backstage and painting scenery at Annables Farm; son Alistair was in the mini-gang number; and husband Colin decided they should all be involved and also started painting the scenery.

Beryl thoroughly enjoys the atmosphere and loves seeing the familiar faces year on year and also the children of those familiar faces - some of whom now appear on stage - the Gang Show circle of life.

David Claridge (Programme)

Having got involved initially supporting Scout activities as a parent helper, David then joined the 10th Harpenden Scout Group Committee for a number of years, latterly serving as Chair until this year.

Inspired by all that the Gang Show creates and achieves, during one rehearsal evening, David asked Ewan Murray 'can I help?' and before finishing the sentence, he was welcomed onto the Committee taking on the Programme role for our 60th Production and has continued ever since. "From start to finish, the achievements of all and the enduring memories are truly remarkable!"

Richard Harrington (County Commissioner and Mini-Gang Sketch Writer and Producer)

Richard is the creator and writer of the Cub or Mini Gang number and has been for fourteen years. He debuted with the Lottery Balls and has been generating original ideas ever since. From this year's Clueless and last year's Horrid Henry and his Six Girlfriends, to Phantom of the Panto and Telecubbies, the themes are expertly woven into a story with appropriately adapted lyrics. Before writing the entire Mini-Gang number, Richard did write occasional sketches for the Junior and Senior Gang and was a 9th Harpenden Cub leader; he now has risen to the dizzy heights of County Commisioner. He always worries he will not be able to think of another theme, so you can always collar him and make your own suggestions!

Richard has many fond memories, many proud moments and is lucky to be surrounded by so many able people in the team that not many disasters have come to light. Apparently Jake the Peg kept losing his third leg but the Wardrobe team were able to avoid disaster with safety pins and sellotape just in the nick of time.

Richard did say that he would give up writing and producing the Mini-Gang number once he was County Commissioner; but last year he was so moved by one Cub who walked five miles on snowy roads to take part in a performance that he decided he absolutely could not give it up.

Jeremy Finch (Sound)

Jeremy has been involved with the show since he first trod the boards as a cub in 1981. He recalls the Ugly Bug Ball number as one of his favourites as a Scout. He ruined his sister's bikini with corks one year in a Scout number, and recalls the fear when he completely forgot his lines in a Right Said Fred solo as a Venture Scout.

He has taken many roles supporting the Show: Make-Up, TV Monitor, Health and Safety, Sketch Production and has been Assistant Sound man for the last six years.


