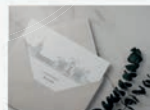

# THE BIG INTERVIEW

*Ewan Murray* - Producer and Musical Director

1

**First, congratulations on being awarded the Silver Wolf by the Chief Scout. What is the Silver Wolf all about?**

Thank you. It's the highest award from The Scout Association for exceptional service. I received a letter from Bear Grylls last summer, I've just been presented with the award, and I'll be at Windsor Castle on St George's Day for a special service along with the first King's Scouts.

**We've not interviewed you for a long time so let's find out more about you and Gang Show! When did you realise you were mad about music?**

I played the recorder at school but after discovering I could play the piano I received a family heirloom as a birthday present. Lessons followed, and the rest is history. I also play guitar and clarinet, and I sing.

**When did you first get involved with Gang Show?**

In 1972 as part of the Mini Gang, going on to the dizzy heights of "front row". I performed in 11 Shows, joined the creative team in 1988, became musical director in 1989 and took over from Marilyn Hudson as producer in 1994.

**Performing on stage is exciting, but what made you decide to volunteer for an off-stage role?**

I volunteer because someone volunteered for me. I know the buzz you get from performing to an audience so I want to give others the same opportunity. I'll paraphrase Forest Witcraft's words from Scouting magazine in 1950: "100 years from now it will not matter the sort of house I lived in, or the kind of car I drove, but the world may be different, because I was important in the life of a child". So many lives have been enhanced because of the confidence that Gang Show has given.

**It takes 10 months to create a Gang Show.  
What's your favourite part of the preparation cycle?**

Show week is exhilarating but putting the Show together is enormous fun! We throw around ideas and listen to hundreds of songs, finally whittling them down to a Show. We have far too many ideas, but that means that we have lots to build on next time!

**You had an extra job in 2022 when you also volunteered to do the National Gang Show. What made you do that?**

Insanity! Nigel Hailey of Warwickshire Gang Show and I started work on an anniversary Show, surrounding ourselves with an army of helpers and a Gang from right across the UK, culminating in a Show at the Eventim Apollo in Hammersmith. Gang Show 90 was a huge challenge, but the amazing team pulled it off. An uplifting experience for all.

**If money were no object what would you have on stage for Gang Show?**

A fly tower above the stage so we could "fly in" scenery for quick transitions. We could do some amazing things! We would, however, need to double the height of the theatre and the neighbours would doubtless object!

**And finally, what is your preferred biscuit for rehearsals?**

Custard creams and shortbread, but really anything that doesn't melt is great. Chocolate on a piano keyboard isn't ideal!

# SUSTAINABLE GANG SHOW



**With 600 costumes being used in Show week, we are trying to reduce waste where possible. Even before the environment became headline news, we reused and repurposed costumes. Some costumes have been reused so many times that we have lost count! Tonight, old Gang members will see clothes they wore in previous Shows, and the spotty skirts that often appear were used back in the 1980s!**



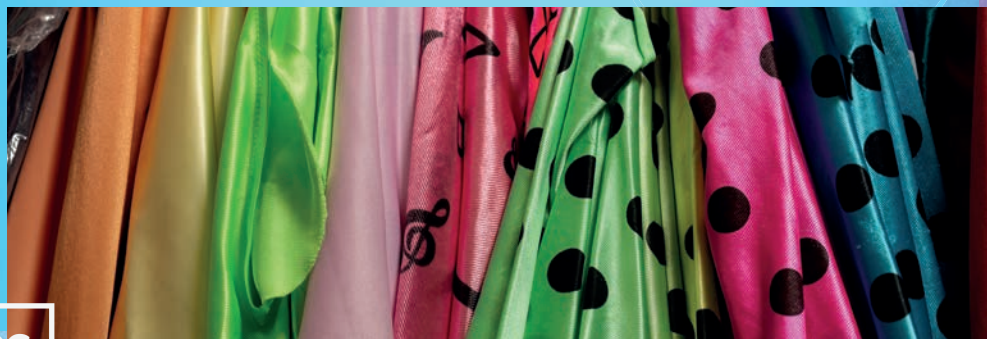
Some costumes have been sourced from charity shops and good quality jumble sales.

Nametags are needed for every costume and this year we are safety pinning named ribbon rather than buying new iron-on tags. The ribbon is easily removed and safety pins reused.

Instead of buying yellow coat hangers, we made a request on our local Facebook and suddenly we had plenty.

Collaboration reduces waste – we often share costumes with other Gang Shows. For Gang Show 90, we made 64 reversible waistcoats and lent out 400 costumes. Some of the waistcoats are on stage tonight!
